Career vs. Job


- A career is the pursuit of a lifelong ambition or the general course of progression towards lifelong goals.

- Selecting a major








For Parents of College Bound Students

- Parents should start the discussion on the idea of college as early as the first year in high school.
- Parents who are focused on test prep and strong grades need to consider the "big picture".
- College admissions offices is looking for extracurricular activities, leadership skills, and ambition too.
- Grades and test scores are only part of the picture.
- Apply at least 10 schools
- Apply early and follow the instructions
- Make sure the Major your student selected is related to the rigorous curriculum you take in high school. i.e. Engineering Major requires more math and physics classes in high school

College Admission

- Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT Score)
- High-school transcript Grade Point Average (GPA) Score
- Application Essay
 - Your education plan?
 - Your education goal?
 - Why do you want to go to this university?
- Other extracurricular activities?
 - Sport, clubs, music, tutoring etc.

Time Management

- Students NEVER have enough time
- So many distractions
- One hour of class time require at least two hours of studying
- Time management: Priority
 - Important task : Must be done
 - Urgent task: Must be done NOW
 - Time to study, time to relax, time to sleep, time to play
- Discipline is important skill to have
- Daily, weekly planning
- You go to school to get educated
- Maturity takes time

- You never know where or in what setting your passions will be discovered, so you must allow yourself the opportunity to explore and take the risk of learning something new. Your future may depend on it.
- Read more about the world in a way in which you are not accustomed to, and open your mind.

- Improve your reading and writing skills and take some computer classes

How to study in College

- Read materials BEFORE coming to class
- Take notes in class, listen well
- Ask questions, if not clear
- For every one hour in class, spend two hours of studying
- Participate in teamwork
- Organize and summarize study note
- Do not study everything at once, space out your study
- Relax
- Exercise
- Sleep






